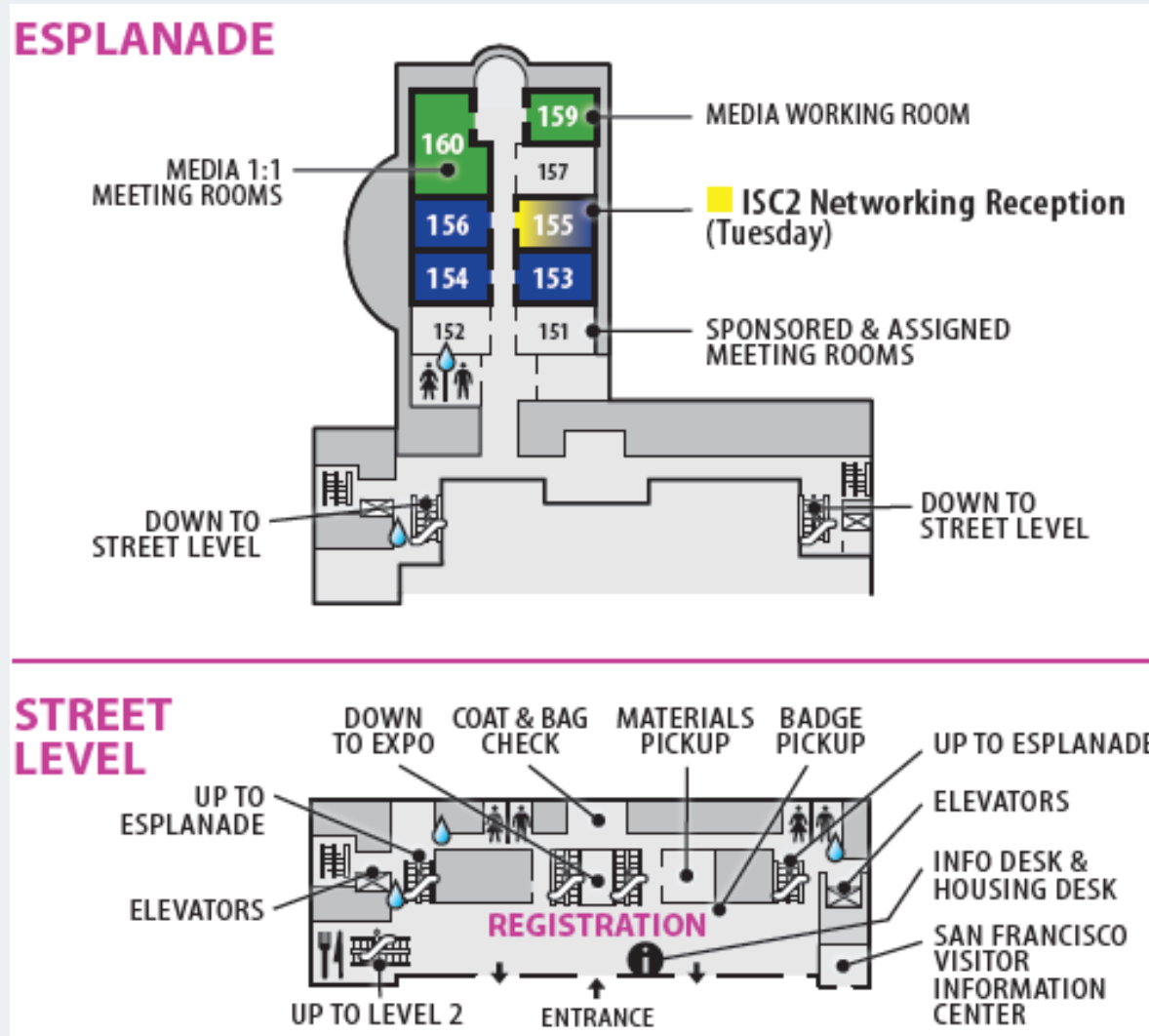

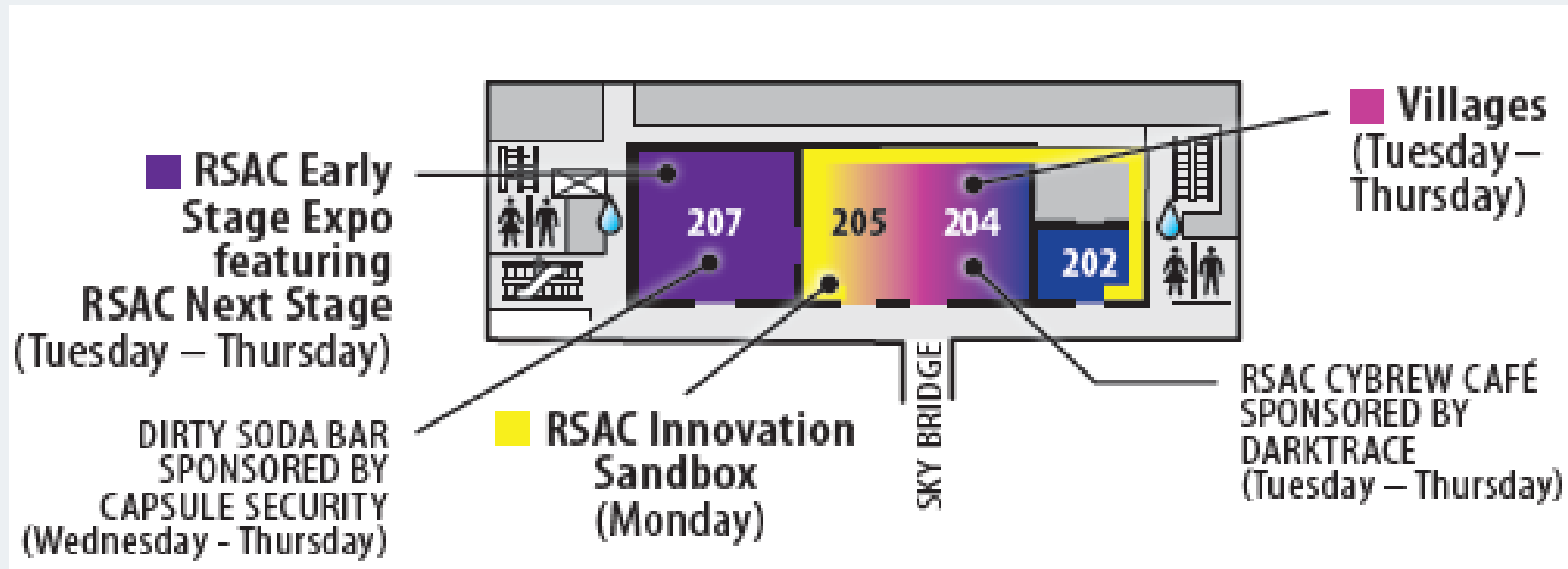

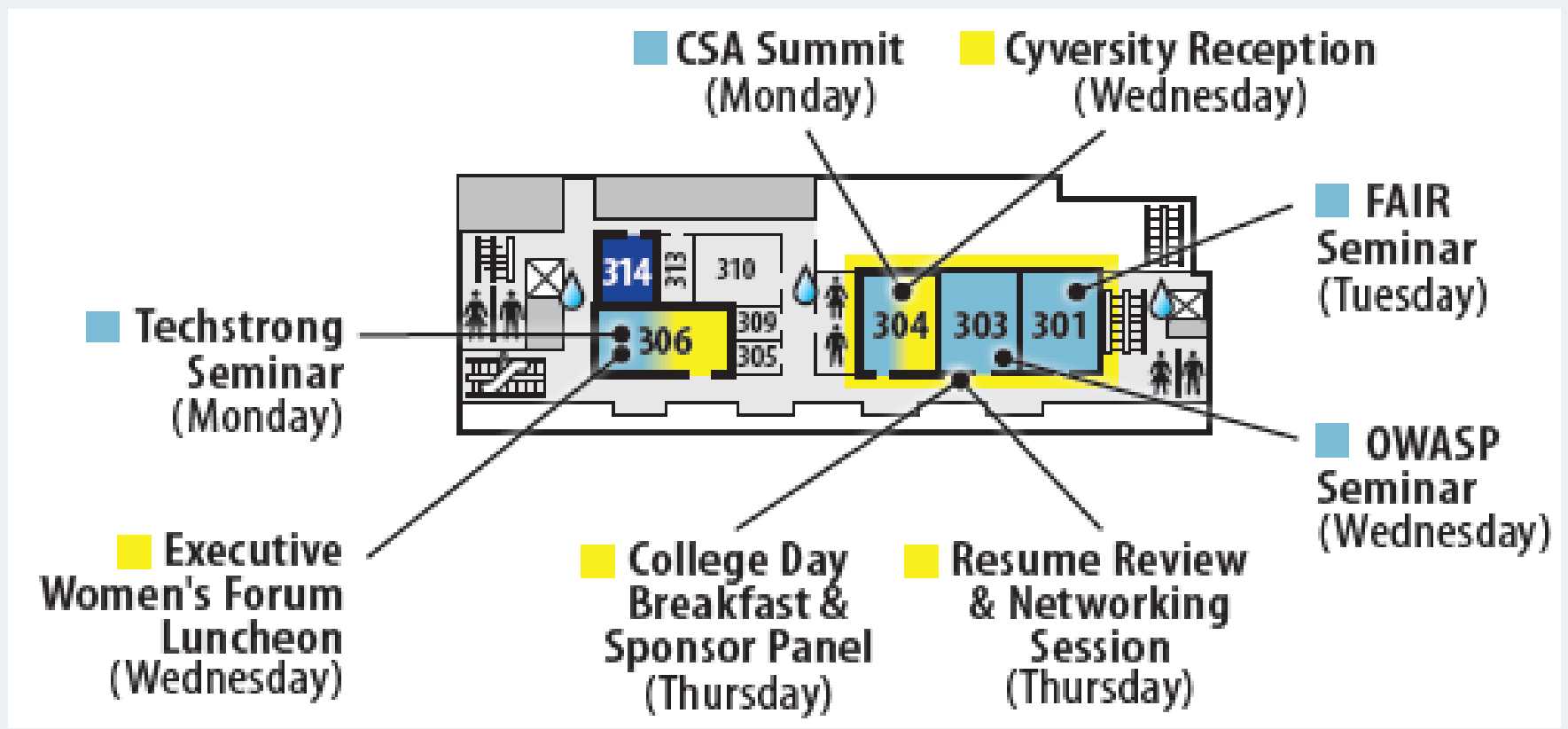
Moscone South: Street Level & Esplanade



Moscone South: Level 2



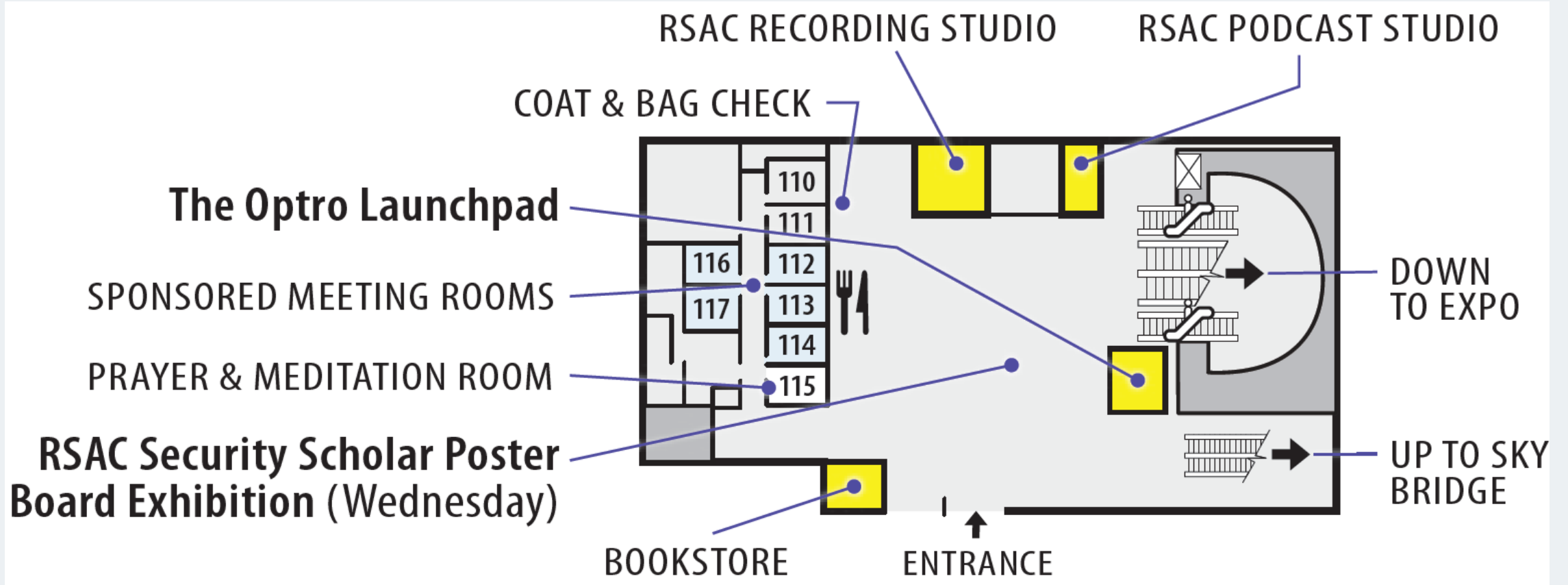
Moscone South: Level 3



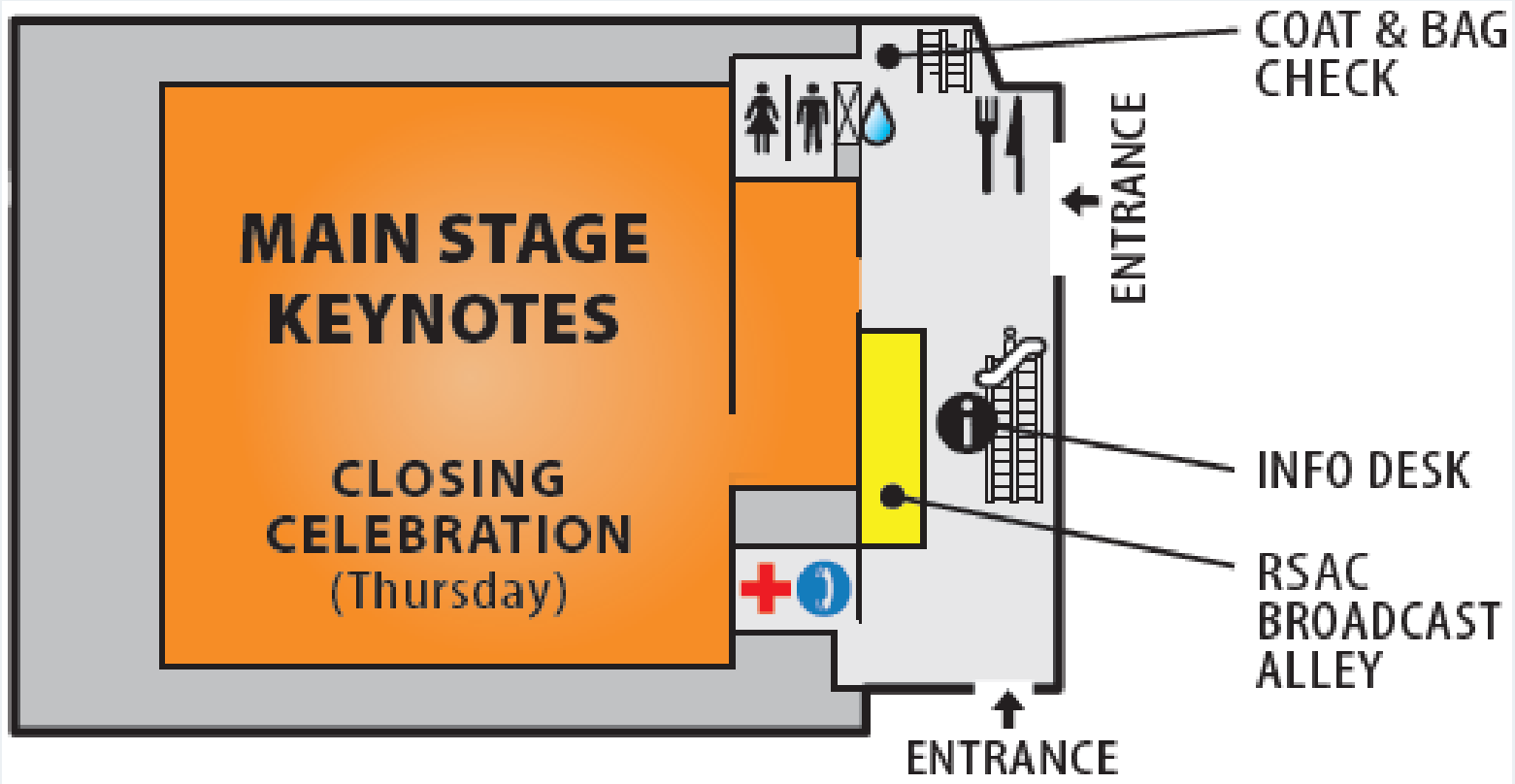
Moscone North & South: Lower Level

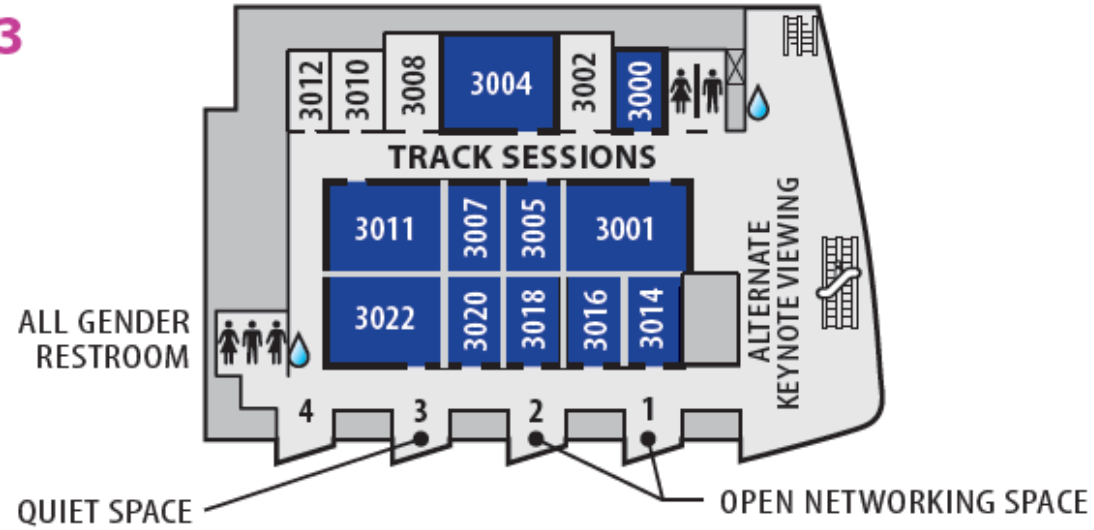

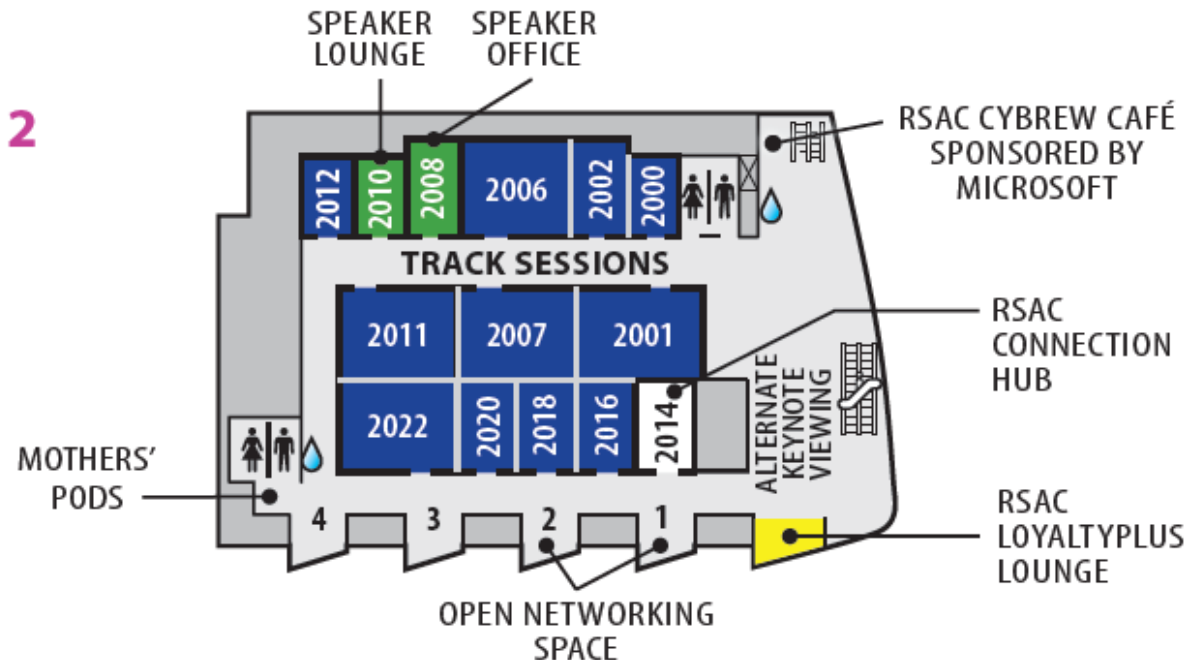

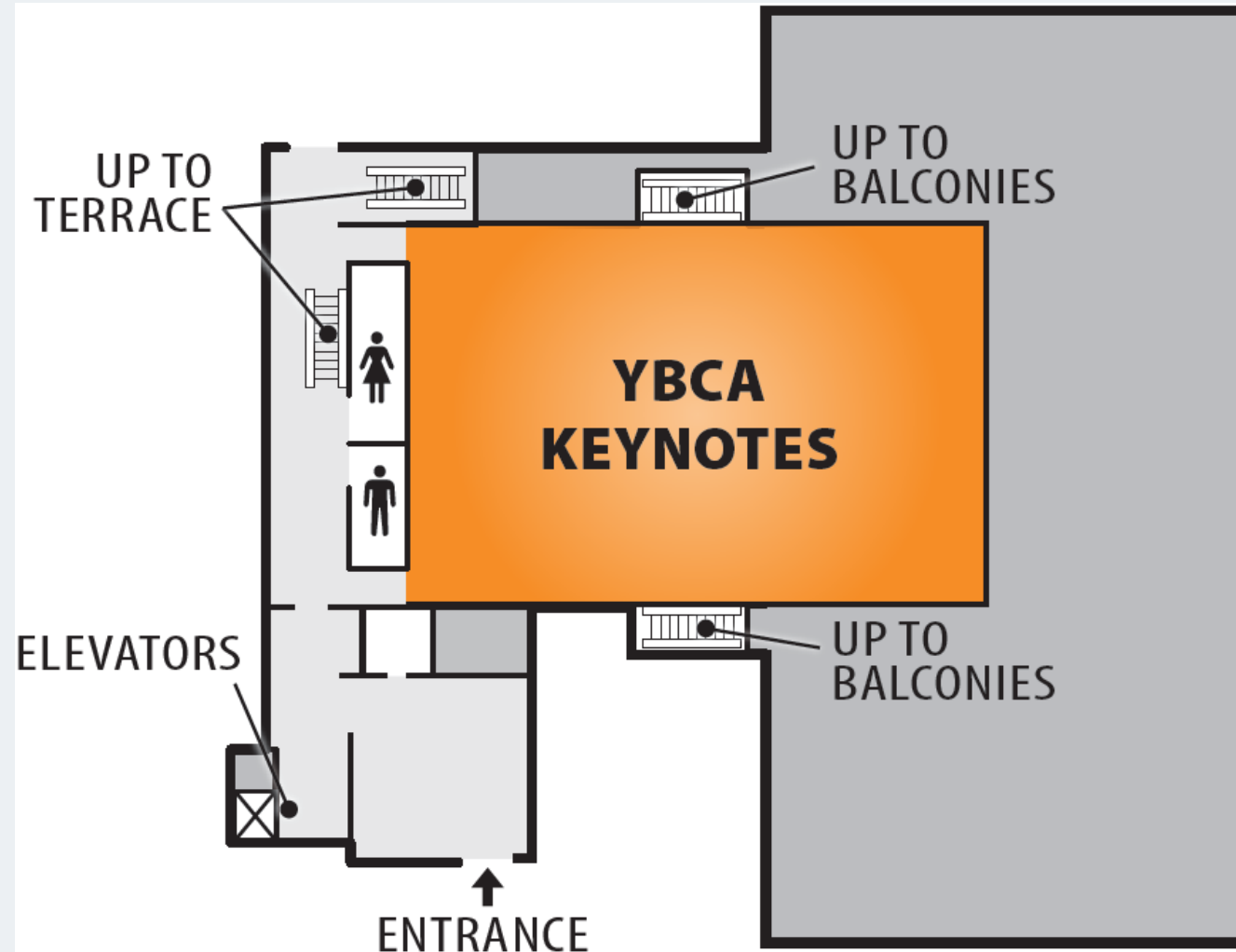

Registration/Check-In

Expo Floor Plan

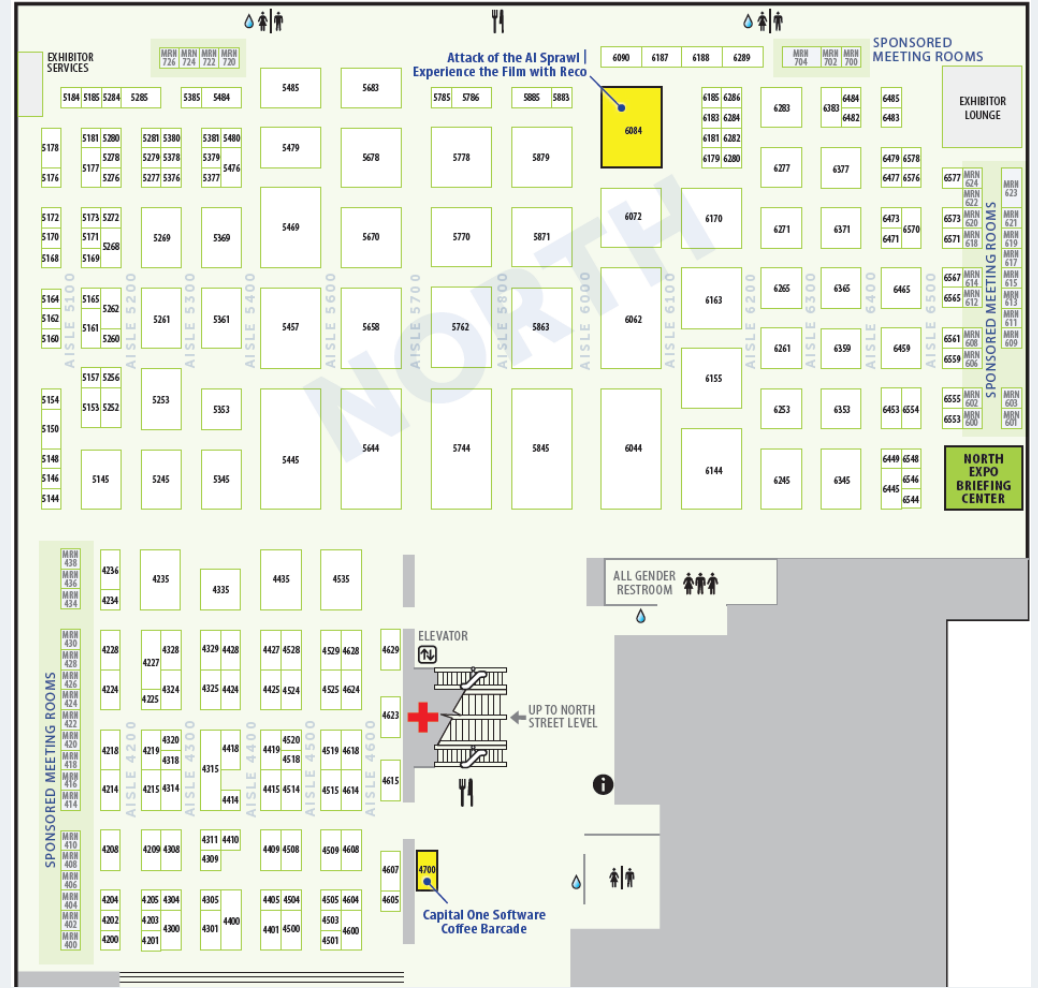

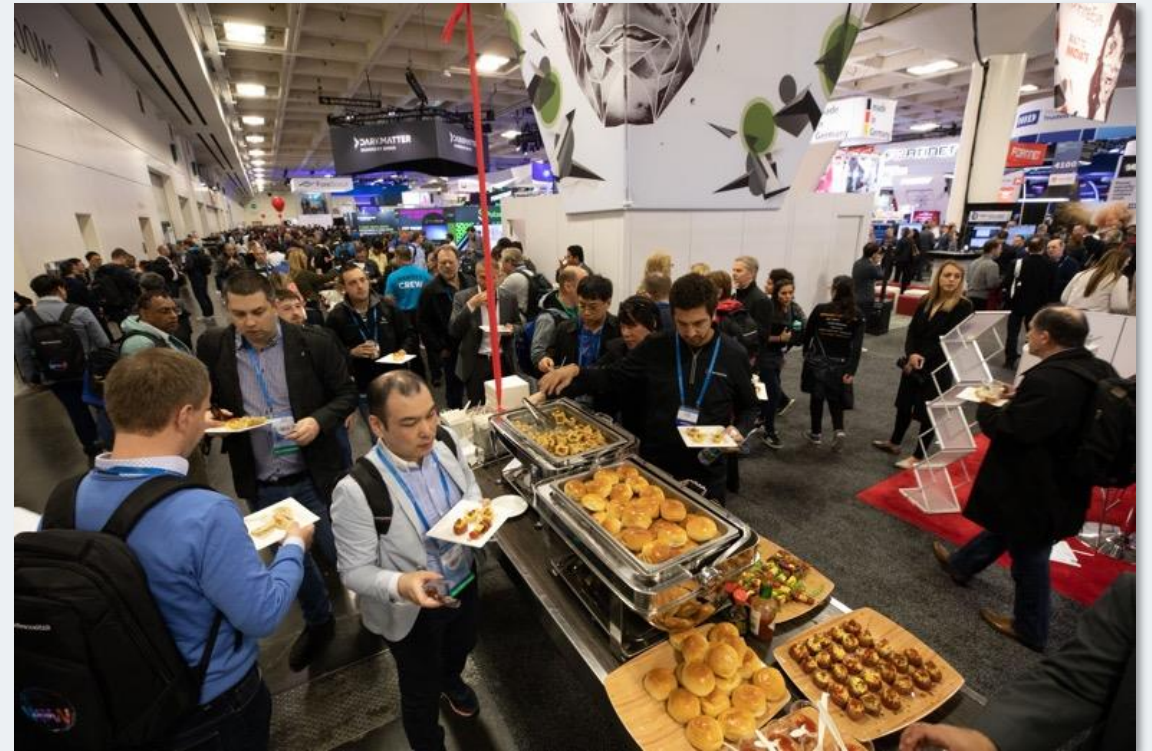

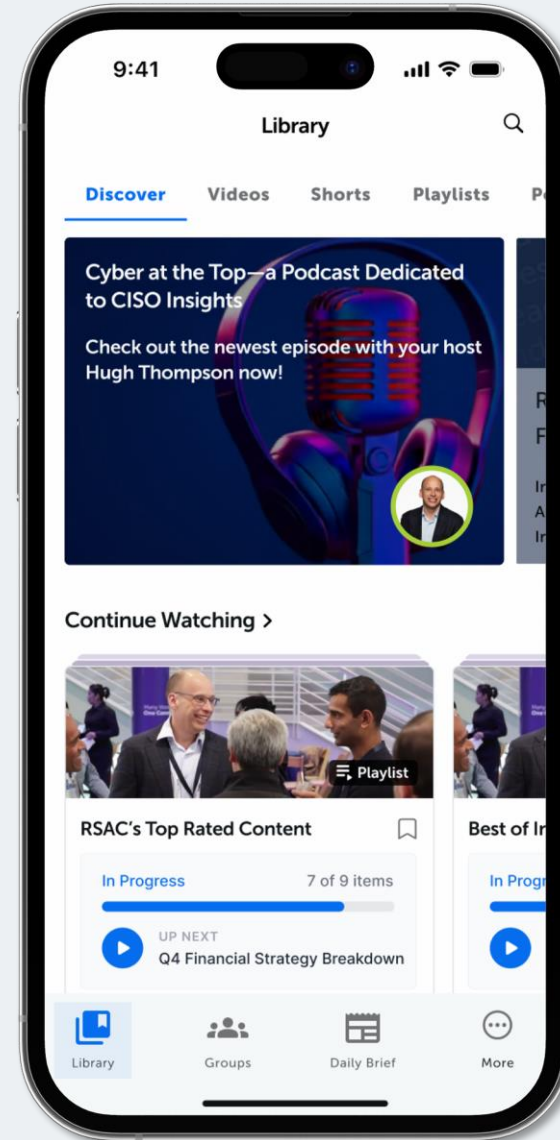

- Wear comfortable shoes and business casual clothing
- Plan ahead
 - Schedule meetings with top executives earlier in the week
 - Schedule sessions you are interested in right away via Reserve Seat. **Remember to be in line at least 5 minutes prior**
 - Keep distance/walking time in mind when scheduling sessions and meetings
- Local information
 - While onsite at Moscone, please visit the San Francisco Visitor Information Center (VIC). They will be located in the far-right doors at Moscone South and will be open Conference week, Sunday – Thursday 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM
