1. INTRODUCTION: Please read these Official Rules (“Rules”) of the RSA CONFERENCE 2016 SESSION / SEMINAR SURVEYS SWEEPSTAKES (“Sweepstakes”). To participate, you must agree to unconditionally accept and comply with the Rules, and the decisions and interpretations of these Rules by the sponsor and administrator, RSA Security LLC, which is located at 174 Middlesex Turnpike, Bedford, MA 01730 U.S.A. (“RSA”). Winning a prize is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein. By entering you agree to comply with these Rules. If you do not agree, do not enter or accept a prize. In these Rules “you” and “your” refer to the participants that enter this Sweepstakes. All times are Pacific Time.

2. ELIGIBILITY: This Sweepstakes is only open to individuals who can verify to RSA’s satisfaction that they: [a] reside in the United States of America or District of Columbia, and not an Exclude Territory, [b] attained the age of at least 21 years by the date their Entry is received; and, [c] successfully registered for (“Registration”) and

attended RSA Conference 2016 in San Francisco, California between February 29, 2016 and March 4, 2016 (“Event”) and received an Event badge (“Badge”).

Badge Scan Required. Your Badge must be scanned at each Presentation you attend to verify your attendance; failure to do so may prevent you from qualifying as a winner, or from receiving an Evaluation and therefore, from receiving an entry for attending that Presentation. Notwithstanding other limitations described in the Rules, if for any reason RSA is unable to offer Badge scanning at a Presentation, RSA may make available a printed Evaluation (see ‘Hand-Written Evaluations’ below).

First Place Prize Daily Drawing: Limitation. Entries submitted before their applicable Cut-Off Time are only eligible to win a First Place Prize (in the Seminar or Session drawing applicable) on the day the Entry was submitted, i.e., the day the underlying Presentation was held. Entries received after the respective Cut-Off Time are ineligible to win a First Place Prize. However, all Entries submitted before the Grand Prize Cut-Off Time are eligible to win the Grand Prize.

Updates to the agenda will generally be made available during the Event. Agenda is subject to change without notice. Not required to attend entire Presentation to enter.

Hand-Written Evaluation Terms. After you request a printed Evaluation form, you must answer the questions, write in your full name, cell phone number, and email address, and submit the completed Evaluation, as instructed during that Presentation, not later than at that Presentation’s conclusion.

Entry Terms. All Entries are subject to the Rules. **Odds of winning depend on number of entries received for that drawing.** Not required to answer all questions on the Evaluation to enter. The answers you provide on an Evaluation do not impact your chance to win. Entries (including answers to all Evaluations) become the property of RSA and their receipt will not be acknowledged or returned. Any attempt by a person to gain more Entries than permitted by the Rules shall result in disqualification at RSA’s sole discretion. Entry into the Sweepstakes does not constitute entry into any other promotion, contest or sweepstakes during the Event or at any other time.

Disputed Entry. For a dispute concerning who submitted an Entry, the Entry will be declared to have been made by the individual with the name and email address corresponding to the information found on the Entry, but only if that person meets all other eligibility criteria. If any dispute cannot be resolved to RSA's satisfaction, the Entry may be deemed ineligible. Entries with more than one name may be disqualified.

4. SELECTION OF POTENTIAL WINNERS AND NOTIFICATION: All First Place Prize winners and the Grand Prize winner are chosen randomly as follows:

- ***First Place Prize Awards-***
 - a) ***SEMINAR-*** One (1) First Place Prize winner will be randomly chosen from among all Seminar Entries submitted before the applicable Cut-Off Time.
 - b) ***SESSION-*** One (1) winner is chosen each day on February 29 thru March 4, 2016. Daily winners are randomly chosen from among the Session Entries submitted by the Cut-Off Time that day, whose Evaluations reflect Presentations that were also held that day.
- ***Grand Prize Award.*** One (1) Grand Prize winner is randomly selected from among all Entries received prior to the applicable Cut-Off Time (on March 4, 2016).

All winners will be chosen within approximately one (1) hour following the applicable drawing's Cut-Off Time. Prize Vendor will select the Grand Prize winner and each of the First Place winners that are drawn from Session Entries; Survey Vendor will select the First Place winner drawn from the Seminar Entries on February 29, 2016. Prize Terms. The Prize or any alternate prize as described herein represents the complete obligation and entire amount awarded the winner by RSA under the Sweepstakes. WITHOUT LIMITING THE GENERALITY OF THE FOREGOING, SUCH PRIZE IS PROVIDED “AS IS” WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EITHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, AND RSA HEREBY DISCLAIMS ALL SUCH WARRANTIES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE AND/OR NON-INFRINGEMENT, EXCEPT WHERE THIS WOULD BE CONTRARY TO NATIONAL, FEDERAL, STATE, PROVINCIAL, OR LOCAL LAWS OR REGULATIONS. RSA shall have no responsibility or obligation to a winner or potential winner who is unable or unavailable to accept or utilize the Prize as described herein.

6. GENERAL PRIZE CONDITIONS: Prior to awarding any prize, RSA, in its sole discretion, may require Entrants to sign and/or return an affidavit of eligibility, publicity release, any required tax forms, and a liability release benefiting RSA (collectively “Prize Claim Documents”) as described herein. RSA reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who is found in RSA's sole judgment to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Sweepstakes, the drawing, submission of Entries, Mobile App, or Event website, to be acting in violation of these Rules, or to be acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with the intent to disrupt or undermine the legitimate operation of the Sweepstakes, or to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person, and RSA reserves the right to seek damages and other remedies from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. ANY ATTEMPT BY AN ENTRANT OR ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE ANY WEBSITE, TAMPER WITH THE ENTRY PROCESS, ANY ENTRIES, OR THE SELECTION PROCESS, OR OTHERWISE UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE SWEEPSTAKES MAY BE A

VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS AND SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, RSA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO COOPERATE IN THE PROSECUTION OF ANY SUCH INDIVIDUAL(S) AND TO PURSUE ALL REMEDIES TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.

Modify Sweepstakes. RSA reserves the right to modify, extend, suspend, or terminate the Sweepstakes if it determines, in its sole discretion, that the Sweepstakes is technically impaired or corrupted or that fraud or technical problems, failures or malfunctions or other causes beyond RSA's control have destroyed or severely undermined or to any degree impaired the integrity, administration, security, proper play and/or feasibility of the Sweepstakes as contemplated herein. Inclusion in such drawing shall be each entrant's sole and exclusive remedy under such circumstances.
