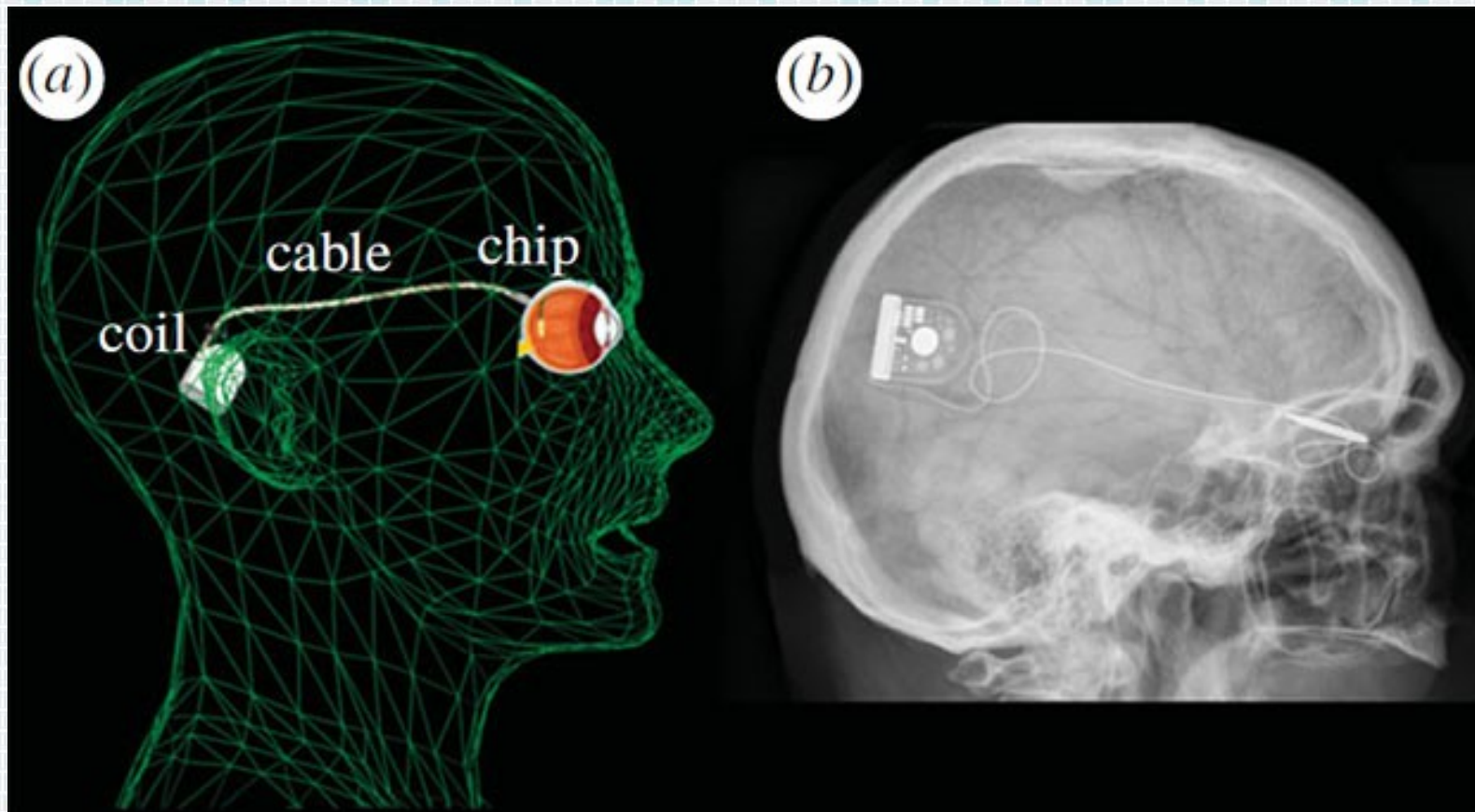






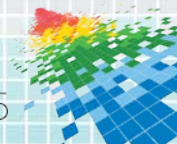
- ◆ ITU-T Recommendation SA 1346, outlines use of the 402- to 405-MHz frequency band for a Medical Implant Communications Service (MICS).
